Quick reference overview

- Step 1 Log in to **Digital Mocks Service** application
- Step 2 From the homepage, click on the series
- Step 3 Click on **Mock exam results**
- Step 4 Click the link of the relevant exam (check it's the exam window you want)
- Step 5 You will see a list of all candidates (overall results screen) and their results if available
- Step 6 Click export overall report (choose from CSV or PDF format)
- Step 7 Open within your computer's download folder
- Step 8 For candidate level results click on the candidate number on **Overall results** screen




Accessing the Digital Mocks Service application

Please note all images shown are examples.

- Reports are accessed via the Digital Mocks Service application accessed via My Cambridge.
- Access **My Cambridge** via https://sso.cambridge.org/login and log in to your account using your registered e-mail address and password.
- If you are a new My Cambridge user you will have received a separate e-mail from us with details of how to create your account.
- Do not use the "create new account" button as it will not be linked to your centre.
- If you haven't received an e-mail with an account, check your spam and then contact your Exams Officer.




On your My Cambridge homepage select the Mocks Service tile by clicking on it.




Selecting centres

Clicking on the **Mock Service** tile in **My Cambridge** will open the homepage of the **Mocks Service** application.

If your centre is registered with more than one exam board or you are registered with more than one centre, you will need to select which centre and exam board you want to book. Click **Save** to continue and open the homepage.




You can switch to a different exam board or centre from the homepage by selecting the centre name in the top left corner of the screen.




Select a series

On the homepage you will see all the available mock exam series for which you can view results if they are available.

Once you have selected a series it will become blue and, if results are available, **Mock exam results** on the side bar menu is enabled (available options are no longer greyed out).




If results are not available, Mock exam results on the side bar menu will remain greyed out.




Accessing results reports

- Click on Mock exam results in the left-hand menu
- Students is the number of students who have sat the exam
- Available results shows the number of students who have available results
- All columns can be sorted using the arrow next to the title (ascending arrow up, descending - arrow down)
- To view results, click on the relevant mock exam check it's the correct exam window as each window has a separate line




Overall results report

- You can now view the overall results for all candidates who sat the exam in the particular window which includes total mark achieved and total percentage mark
- The results can be viewed on screen alternatively you can download a csv or pdf report of the overall results
- To download the Overall Results Report, click Export overall report
- Select either CSV or PDF format
- The attempt status shows the marking status of the exam
 - o Pending exam has not yet been completed and results are not available
 - o Marking the exam has been completed and marking is in progress
 - Marked marking is complete, and results are ready to be viewed



Your download of the report should appear in the top right corner of your screen when complete and can be opened from here or accessed from your computer's download folder.



The **Overall Results Report** lists each student with the marks achieved out of marks available and the % mark they achieved for the exam.


